








## EIP-AGRI project database

- New database (December 2023) on the EU CAP Network website
- Around 3000 EIP OGs and 500 research and innovation projects including Horizon multi-actor projects
- To be regularly updated with new projects (CAP 2023-2027 and Horizon Europe)
- > 1020 projects working on 'soil' (free text search), 772 of those are OGs (April 2024)
